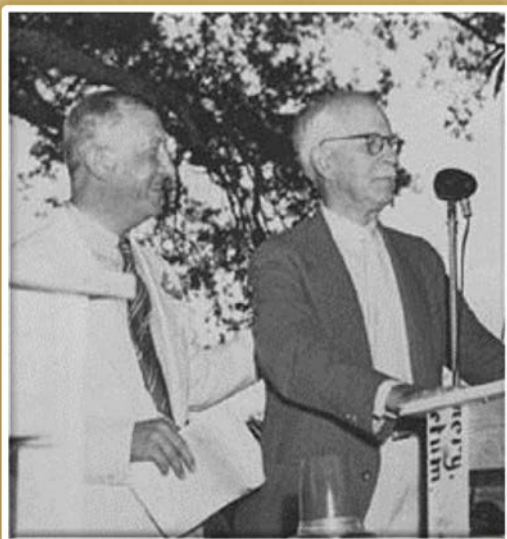

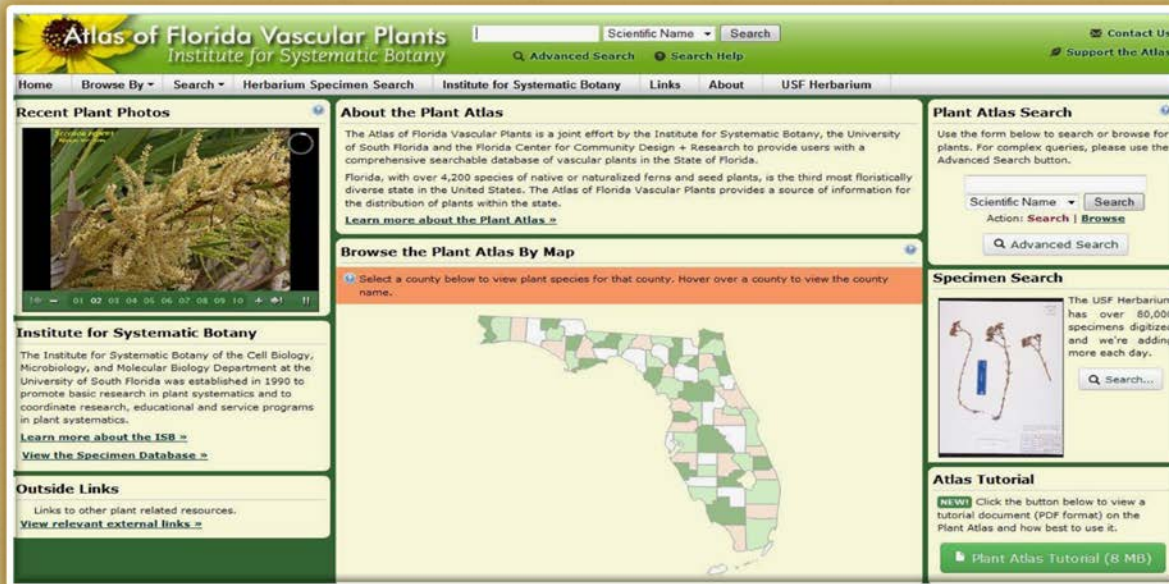


Specialized Computer Equipment for

Slash Pine Project, c. 1980

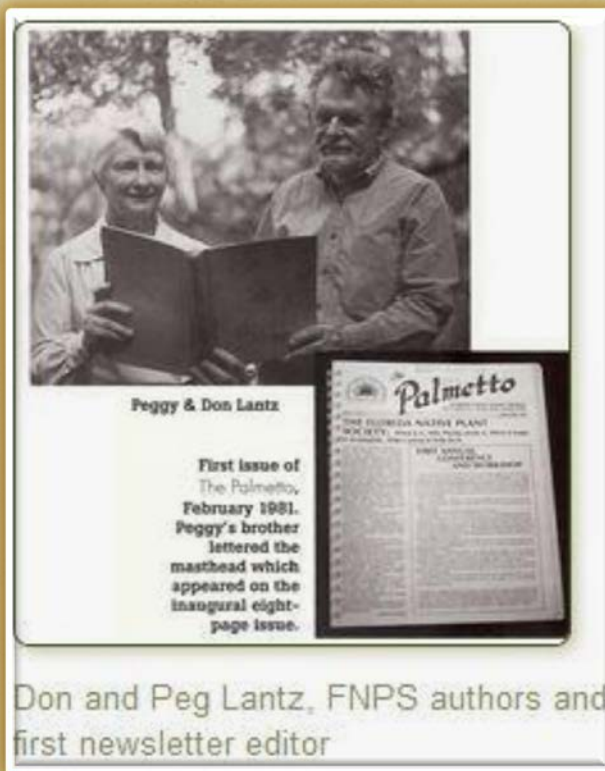
University of South Florida Herbarium

- Plants from Florida (40%), with strong holdings from North America north of Mexico (37%) and Latin America (13%)
- Largest collection in the world of materials from central and southern Florida

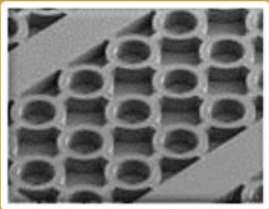

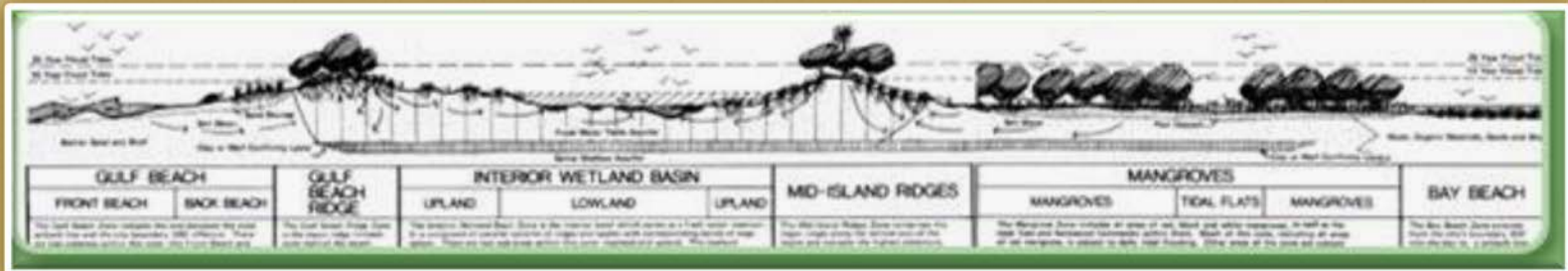
