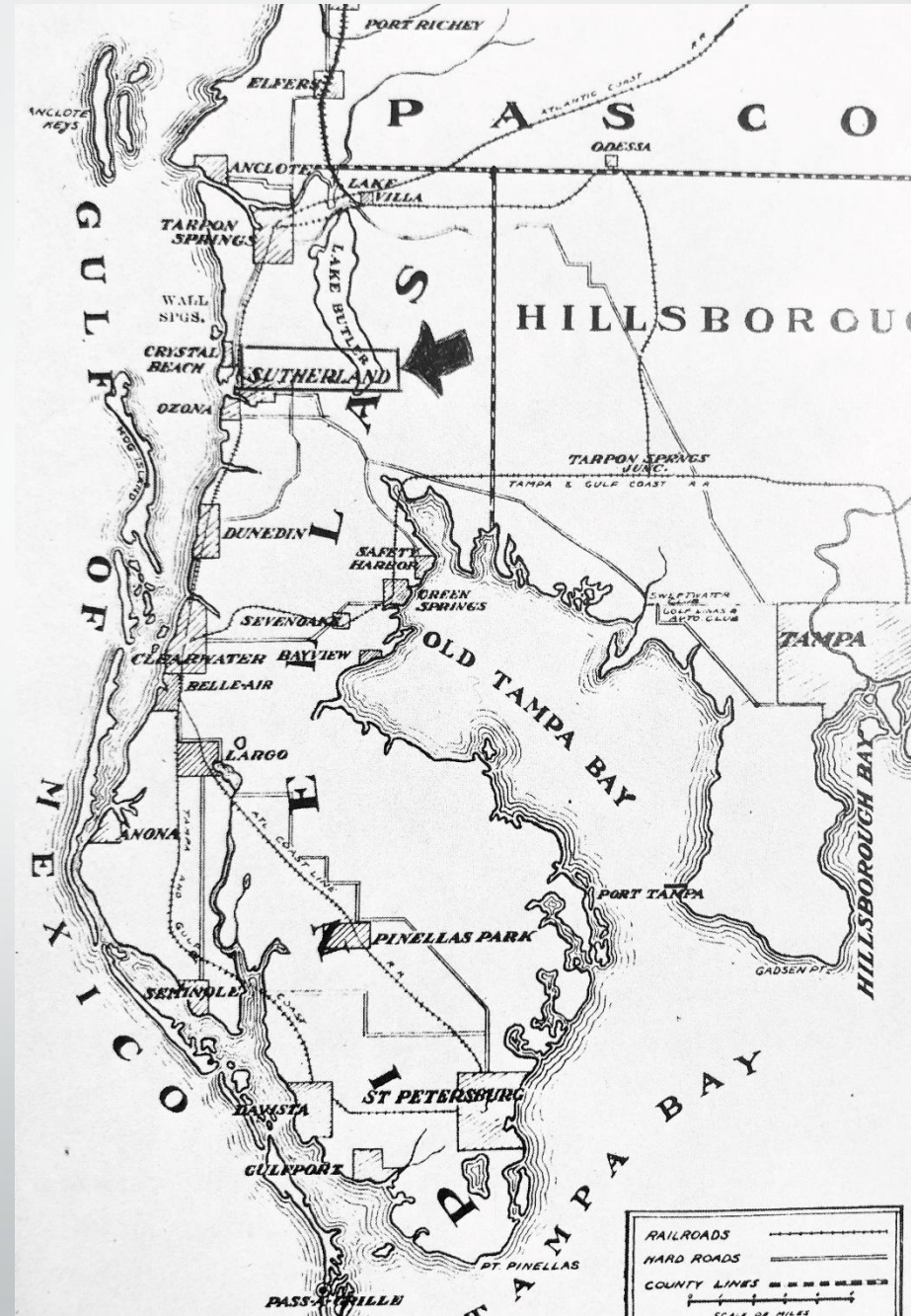

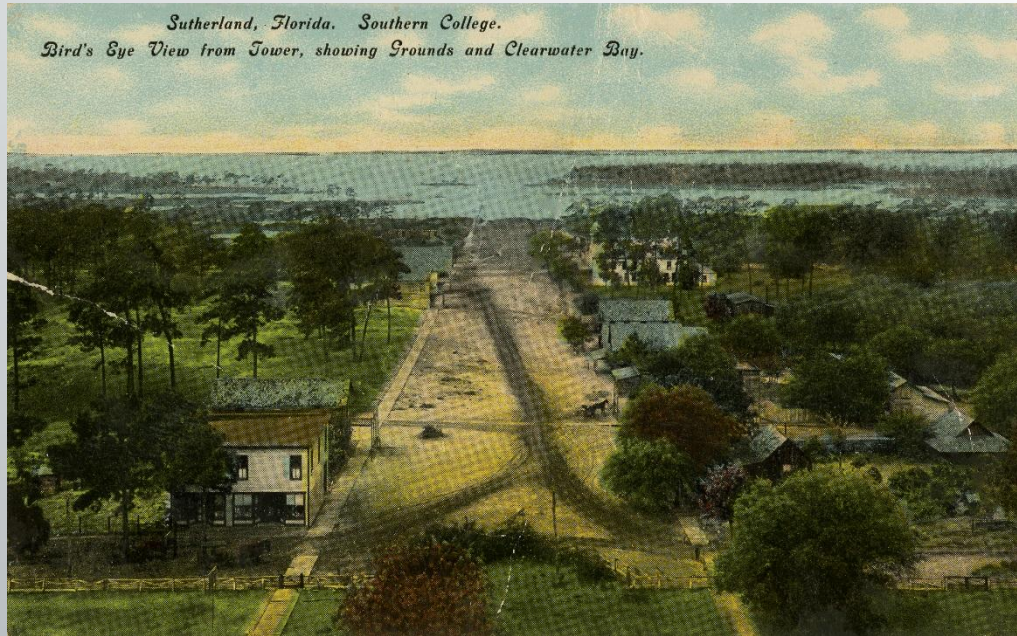
Locations of College - 1885 to present

Sutherland Florida



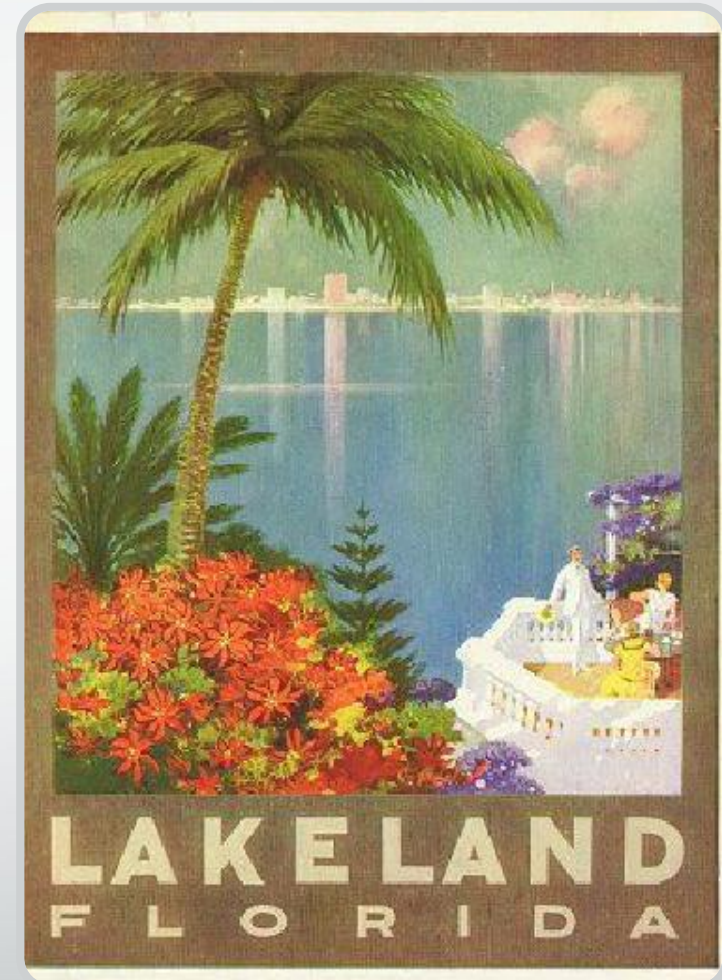
Southern College c. 1911

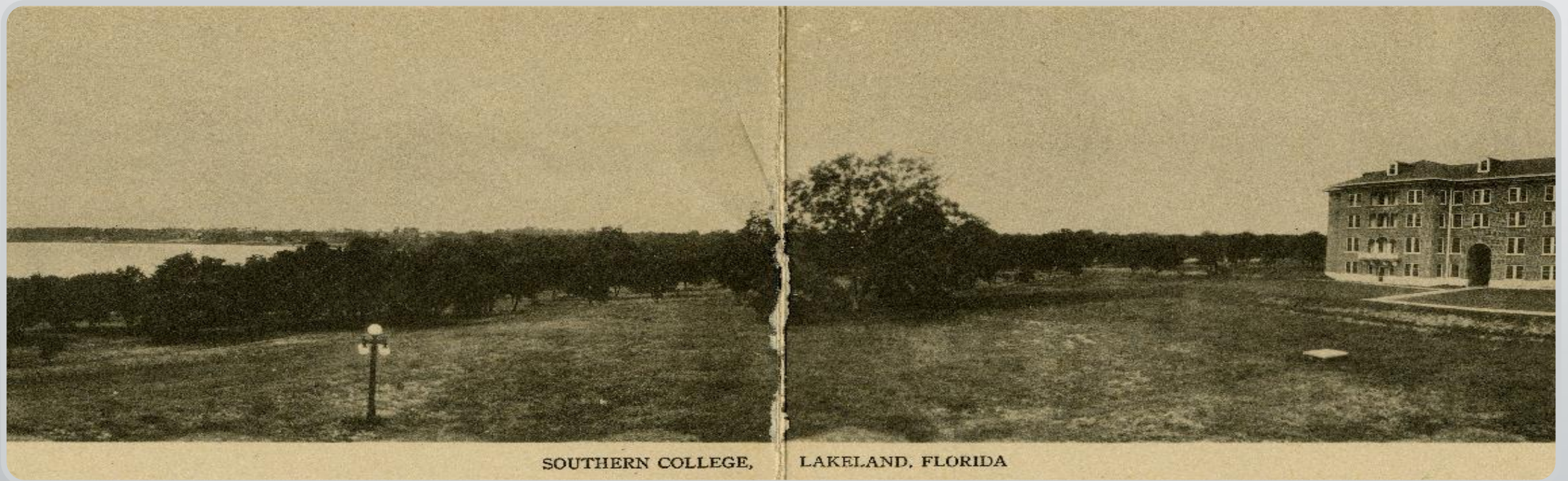




Hotel owned by E.T. Roux, where classes resumed two weeks after the January 29, 1921 fire. This also served as the girls dormitory.

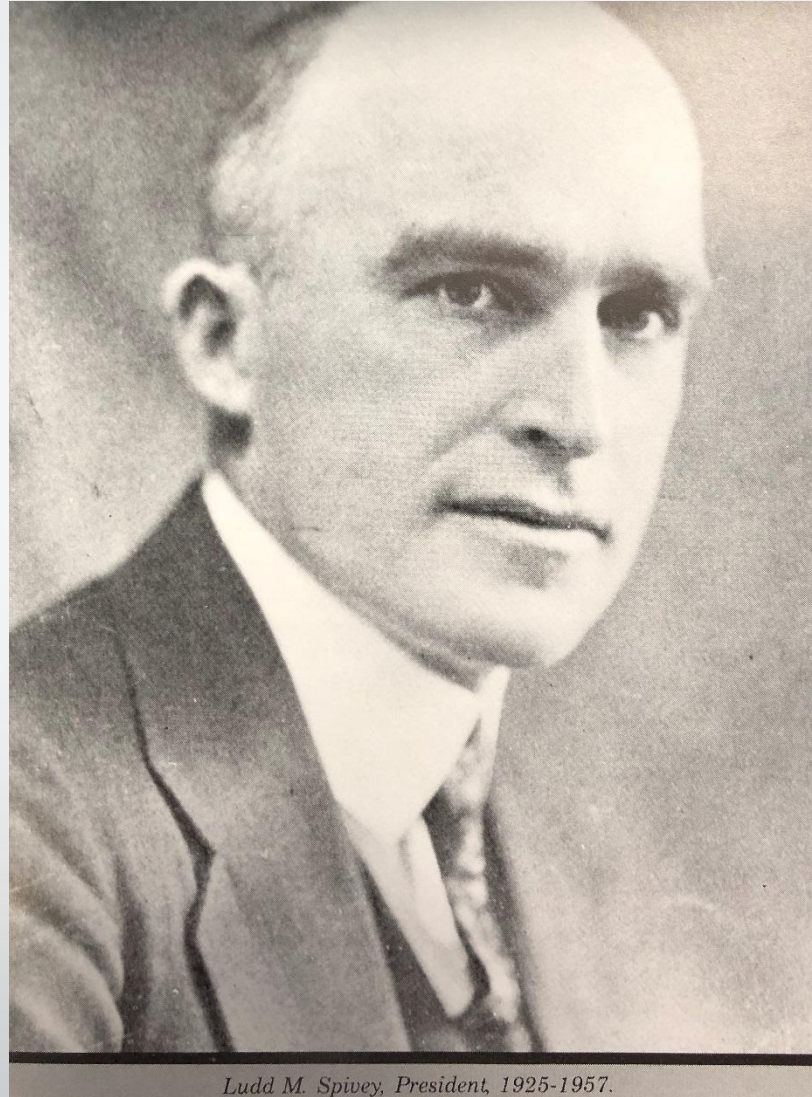
The city fathers of Lakeland offered a site of 78 acres, 67 of which were covered in mature citrus trees.
